5th Grade Supply List

- Backpack or school bag
- Folder Suggestions: The goal here is to make sure your student has paper and a pocket folder for each subject. Some suggestions are; “Trapper Keeper”, 3-ring binder, accordion file folder system or 5-Star subject notebook with built-in folders.
 - *if using accordion or 5-star, also need 1 homework folder
 - *if using trapper keeper or 3-ring binder, also need 5 plain 2-pocket folders w/holes and 1 homework folder
- 2 packages of wide rule notebook paper and 1 package of white copy paper
- Sharp scissors (1), glue sticks (2), highlighter markers (4)
- Standard/metric ruler (1), protractor (1) (both can be purchased from the school store)
- 24 #2 pencils – **no** ink pens please
- Classic colored pencils (or) 10 pack of classic colored skinny markers
- Small personal size white board and 2 (black or blue) dry erase markers
- Refillable water bottle
- 1 pair of non-marking soled tennis shoes for gym class and to wear in classroom
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 2 packages of Clorox cleaning wipes
- ALL supplies will need to be replenished when depleted during the school year (many can be purchased from our school store).

Important Note:

The students will begin to learn how to use a scientific calculator, which will be provided by the school and billed to parent accounts to ensure all students have the same type. The calculator can be used through Geometry in high school.

A classroom Bible will be necessary, NIV is preferred. They are available for purchase in the office for \$8.50. Also available and highly recommended instead of the classroom Bible is the NIV Adventure Study Bible. The cost is \$20.

Please cover the Friday Folder the student will receive with clear contact paper.

All hard cover textbooks (2) must be covered and kept covered all year. There will be charges assessed for excessive damage to textbooks that are not kept covered, are abused or are lost.

Boots, snow pants and coat (or snowsuit), hat and gloves (mittens) are required in the winter.

Please label all clothing and belongings with permanent marker.
